What is the UAC preference code for the Diploma in Languages?

The UAC preference code is 489980.

How should I arrange my preferences if and accept offer if...

1. I only want to enrol in the Diploma in Languages?

Place the Diploma in Languages as your first preference in time for the Main Round of UAC offers.

2. I want to receive an offer to both an undergraduate program and the Diploma in Languages at the University of Newcastle and commence both programs in 2010

- Apply for both programs through UAC and place your choice of Bachelor programs in order of preference in time for the Main Offer Round with the Diploma in Languages as your last preference.
- Please email admissions@newcastle.edu.au with your name, your UAC application number and to advise that you are intending to enrol in both programs.
- If you receive an offer for the Bachelor program, accept it at the University of Newcastle acceptance website:
<http://www.newcastle.edu.au/students/new/accepting-your-offer.html>. You should then also log onto your UAC application and remove the code for the program you have been offered and place the Diploma in Languages as your first preference.
- Subject to Faculty approval for concurrent enrolment and availability of places, you will be offered the Diploma in Languages in the later offer round. **Do not accept this offer online.** Send the offer slip you receive from UAC to the address at the bottom of this document. Please indicate on the offer slip that you wish to accept the offer for the Diploma in Languages.

3. I am already studying a program at the University of Newcastle and want to study the Diploma in Languages concurrently with my current program in 2010?

- Place the Diploma in Languages as your first preference on your UAC application. Please email admissions@newcastle.edu.au with your name, your UAC application number and to advise that you are intending to enrol in both programs.
- If you receive an offer for the program, **do not accept this offer online.** Send the offer slip you receive from UAC to the address at the bottom of this document. Please indicate on the offer slip that you wish to accept the offer for the Diploma in Languages.

4. I want to study a postgraduate program concurrently with the Diploma in Languages?

Please email admissions@newcastle.edu.au with your name, your UAC application number and to advise that you are intending to enrol in both programs.

Commencing postgraduate students

If you want to commence study for the Diploma in Languages at the same time as a postgraduate program, you should submit to UAC a postgraduate application and a separate undergraduate application for the Diploma in Languages.

If the postgraduate program is available for study online, you may be able to apply direct to the University. Visit www.gradschool.com.au for further information.

Current Postgraduate Students

If you are already studying at the University of Newcastle, you will need to submit an undergraduate application with UAC. Please ensure you have the Diploma in Languages as your first preference.

Postgraduate offers are made on a regular basis, but closing dates will vary, so check with the UAC postgraduate application website before applying. If you receive an offer, **do not accept it online**. Send the offer slip you receive from UAC to the address below. Please indicate on the offer slip that you wish to accept the offer for the Diploma in Languages.
