INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED IN THE BACHELOR OF ARTS [40096] PRIOR TO 2023

There are changes to the program in 2023.

The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs as a 10-unit course for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards. Within the Bachelor of Arts, this course is HUMA2000 – Local Placements. WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes.

Transition Arrangements

Students who commenced prior to 2023 are not required to complete 10 units from the Work Integrated Learning course list (HUMA2000) and will retain the additional 10 units of electives. These students may choose to take HUMA2000 as an elective.

There are changes to the program in 2023.

The Film, Media and Cultural Studies Major is discontinued and replaced by the Screen and Cultural Studies Major.

Students who graduate from the program in 2022 and who are undertaking the Film, Media and Cultural Studies Major will graduate with this Major.

Students who are continuing in the program in **2023** and who are undertaking the Film, Media and Cultural Studies Major will be transferred to the **Screen and Cultural Studies Major**.

Reflecting this change, several course codes and course titles have also been updated. The following table displays a summary of the approved course equivalency arrangements for students who commenced in the Bachelor of Arts [40096] prior to 2023.
