The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs (SOCS3300 – Social Science Placement or ENVS3008 – Work Integrated Learning in the Environmental and Development Sectors). WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes. ENVS3008 has been revised to increase the placement hours from 80 to 140 hours for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards.

Transition Arrangements

Students who commenced the program prior to 2023 and not successfully completed SOCS2100, will be required to complete 10 units of a WIL Directed course, A choice of either SOCS3300 or ENVS3008.
