To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Specialisation - All core courses and the required number of directed courses must be completed.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 1 year full time, or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
- ✓ Part time students typically enrol in 10-20 units each Semester (2-4 years part time).
- ✓ 2018 course availability is subject to change.
