From 2021 the following changes have been made to the listed majors:

### **Criminology**

 CRIM2010 Media Criminology has been removed from the Compulsory course list and added to the Directed course list and replaced with CRIM2030 Criminology in the Legal Context

If you have not already completed **CRIM2010** you must complete **CRIM2030**. If you have room in the major you can choose to complete **CRIM2010** as a directed course.

There have been additional changes to the Directed course list. Courses completed pre-2021 will count towards this Major.

### Human Geography and the Environment

 GEOG3240 Globalisation: Cities, Economies has been removed from the Compulsory course list and replaced with ENVS3006 Surviving the Anthropocene: Sustainability in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

If you have not already completed GEOG3240 you must complete ENVS3006.

There have been changes to the Directed course list. Courses completed pre-2021 will count towards this Major.

#### Leisure and Tourism

The Leisure and Tourism Major has been renamed Tourism and Event Management.

All students completing this major after 2021 will qualify with Tourism and Event Management.

• TOUR3004 Specialised Sectors of the Tourism Industry has been removed from the Compulsory course list and replaced with LEIS3003 Event Strategy and Leadership.

If you have not already completed TOUR3004 you must complete LEIS3003.

There have been changes to the Directed course list. Courses completed pre-2021 will count towards this Major.

#### **Politics and International Relations**

- A reduction in the number of **Compulsory** course requirements from 50 units to 40 units.
- An increase in the number of **Directed** course requirements from 30 unit to 40 units.
- **POLI2001 Ideas in Political Science** has been **removed** from the **Compulsory** course list and **replaced** with **POLI2203 International Political Economy and Global Development.**



- *POLI3002 Power and the State* has been **removed** from the **Compulsory** course list and **replaced** with *POLI3180 Politics, Policy and Government*.
- **POLI3150 Issues in International Relations** has been **removed** from the **Compulsory** course list and added to the **Directed** course list.

If you have not completed POLI2001 you must complete POLI2203.

If you have not completed **POLI3002** you must complete **POLI3180**, unless you have already completed **POLI2180** Politics, Policy and Government. POLI2180 will then count towards the Compulsory Course requirements in place of **POLI3180**.

If you have completed **POLI3150** this will count as a 10 unit Directed course.

There have been changes to the Directed course list. Courses completed pre-2021 will count towards this Major.

### Sociology and Anthropology

- A reduction in the number of **Compulsory** course requirements from 40 units to 30 units.
- An increase in the number of **Directed** course requirements from 40 unit to 50 units.
- **SOCA3750 Investigating the Social: Contemporary Approaches** (20 units) has been **removed** from the **Compulsory** course list and **replaced** with **SOCA3780 Social Lab** (10 units).

If you have completed **SOCA3750** you will complete 40 units of Compulsory courses and 40 units of Directed courses.

If you have not already completed **SOCA3750** you will complete 30 units of Compulsory courses and 50 units of Directed Courses (with at least 30 units at the 3000 level).

There have been changes to the Directed course list. Courses completed pre-2021 will count towards this Major.
