Important Information for students who commenced in the program prior to 2021.

This program has been revised for implementation from Semester 1 2021.

- From 2021 there are changes to the compulsory and directed course requirements for the following B Arts majors/minors:
 - Ancient History and Classical Languages
 - English and Writing
 - History
 - Politics and International Relations
 - Sociology and Anthropology
- The **Directed** courses list for most majors and minors have been amended. Courses completed prior to 2021 will count towards the Directed course requirements for the major/minor.

B Music Core Course: **MUSI3203 Professional Project** has been replaced with **CIND3003 Creative Industries Professional Project**.

Courses completed pre-2021 will count towards the program; however, you **must** refer to both the **Bachelor of Arts Transition Arrangements** and **Bachelor of Music Transition Arrangements**.

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses - 140 units.
- ✓ Major 1 - 80 units (including compulsory courses).
- ✓ Major 2 - 80 units (including compulsory courses).
- ✓ Students must only complete courses that form part of the program.
- ✓ Directed Courses - 20 units (selected from the Bachelor of Music/Bachelor of Arts [Program Handbook](#)).
- ✓ The duration of this program is 4 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
