## INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED IN THE BACHELOR OF DEVELOPMENT STUDIES/BACHELOR OF BUSINESS [40101] PRIOR TO 2023

---

The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs as a 10-unit Core Course (ENVS3008 – Work Integrated Learning in the Environmental and Development Sectors or BUSN3002 – Industry Placement). WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes. ENVS3008 and BUSN3002 have been revised to increase the placement hours from 80 to 140 hours for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards.

### Transition Arrangements

Students who commenced the program prior to 2023 will have the opportunity to complete either the revised ENVS3008 or BUSN3002 as part of their major.
