## **Bachelor of Food Science and Human Nutrition/Bachelor of Business**

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED IN THE BACHELOR OF FOOD SCIENCE AND HUMAN NUTRITION/BACHELOR OF BUSINESS [40102] PRIOR TO 2023

The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs as a 10-unit Core Course (FSHN3500 – Professional Practice or BUSN3200 – Industry Placement), for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards. WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes.

## **Transition Arrangements**

Pre-2023 students will continue with a 20-unit Area of Interest (AOI) Directed Course list. Students who self-select may complete FSHN3500 as part of their program as a replacement for FSHN3090, which has been removed from the AOI directed course list. All students who commence the degree in 2023 will be required to follow the new structure and complete either FSHN3500 or BUSN3200 as part of their program.
