A Major or Minor is an area of study that you wish to focus on in your program. A course will count towards your Major or Minor if it is listed as a Compulsory or Directed course under the relevant Major in the <u>Program Handbook</u>. Studies of Religion teacher	Students should enrol in no more than 20 units in any one religious tradition, and should not complete more than 10 units of AHIS courses (ancient religious history or traditions).
