To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 240 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Major 1 80 units (including compulsory courses).
- ✓ Minor 1 40 units (including compulsory courses).
- ✓ Minor 2 40 units (including compulsory courses).
- Electives 80 units. Visit the <u>Course Handbook</u> to see a list of available Electives.
- ✓ Students must complete a minimum of 40 units and a maximum of 100 units at each level (1000, 2000, and 3000).
- ✓ The duration of this program is 3 years full time study (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 8 years.



Some courses have assumed knowledge and/or requisites, please refer to the individual <u>Course Handbook</u>. The <u>Program Handbook</u> has valuable information on program structure and requirements, if you are intending on studying part time or varying from this program plan please seek prior advice from your <u>Program Advisor</u>.

Bachelor of Arts Major/Minor Sequences

A major or minor is an area of study that you wish to focus on in your program. A course will count towards your major or minor if it is listed as a compulsory or directed course under the relevant major in the program handbook. You must complete 80 units in your major, and 40 units in your minor, as follows:-

- 1. 20 units of 1000 level courses for each Major/Minor, including all 1000 level compulsory courses in each Major/Minor.
- 2. 20 units of 2000 level courses for each Major/Minor, including 10 units of 2000 level Compulsory courses in each Major/Minor.
- 3. 40 units of 3000 level courses for your Major only, including 20 units of 3000 level Compulsory courses in each Major only.

*This Major/Minor structure does not apply to those students completing a French Studies or Japanese Studies Intermediate Sequence Major/Minor. See below.
