- ✓ Core Courses (including Professional Placement) 140 units.
- ✓ Major 80 units. To meet the requirements of the major sequence please refer to the <u>Program Handbook</u> for the specific rules for each Major.
- ✓ Minor 1 60 units. Students may elect to utilise 20 units of their elective to upgrade their minor to a major, in which case they must ensure that they follow Major program rules. Please note Chinese and Legal studies may only be undertaken as a Minor.
