**DOAJ - Directory of Open Access Journals** - Multidisciplinary. DOAJ is an online directory linking to 350 quality controlled, freely available scientific and scholarly journals

**Kluwer Online Journals** - More than 650 full text journals published in physical sciences, social sciences and humanities, engineering and computer sciences, biosciences and behavioural sciences

**Mega File Premier** - Multidisciplinary, 18 mostly full text databases
