

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING AND BUILT ENVIRONMENT 2007 POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH PRIZES



Every year, the Faculty of Engineering and Built Environment (FEBE) awards up to eight prizes for postgraduate research excellence in the following categories:

- Architecture and Industrial Design (Arch/ID)
- Building (Build)
- Civil Engineering (CivE)
- Chemical Engineering (ChE)
- Computer Science and Software Engineering (CS/SE)
- Electrical, Computer and Telecom. Engineering (EE/CE/TE)
- Environmental Engineering and Surveying (Env/Surv)
- Mechanical and Mechatronics Engineering (ME)

The prize involves \$400 cash and a certificate attesting to the award. This is presented to the winners at the Annual Newcastle Postgraduate Students Association (NUPSA) Dinner. In exceptional circumstances, the prize committee may also deem "honourable mention" awards which will also be presented at this function.

The awards are judged on the basis of a poster presentation which takes place in the foyer of the Auchmuty Library in weeks 10 and 11 (10 September - 21 September) of Semester 2. The winning entries will be invited to take part in a semi-permanent display in the Auchmuty Library foyer for the remainder of the semester.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Currently enrolled in a Research Higher Degree at the University of Newcastle, with Principle Supervisor residing in the Faculty of Engineering and Built Environment (FEBE)
- Completion of at least two semesters of full time equivalent study towards their Research Higher Degree
- Previous years recipients are not eligible to apply

The selection committee reserves the right to not award a prize in any particular category.
