The value of these PhD Scholarships is \$29,000 per annum for a maximum of 3.5 years, and is offered under a two way financial commitment between Australian Rotary Health (\$18,000pa) and the administering University/Research Institution (\$11,000pa).

Applicants must be full-time students, enrolled within a recognised university or research institute in Australia. Only applicants about to commence a PhD, or those already engaged within the first year of a PhD, are eligible to apply.
