WHY

- **Promote** the EBLIP model
- **Encourage** library practitioners from all sectors to incorporate EBLIP as routine practice
- **Enable** application of the EBLIP model by library practitioners

HOW

- **Promotion** – establish a recognisable identity for “Libraries Using Evidence” (*domain name, logo*)
- **People** – a gateway to support from “evidence-based practice” community (*listservs, practitioners, events*)
- **Practice/projects** – a directory of current research & activities, in the literature, locally and beyond (*our projects, others projects, what’s new, collections of studies etc*)
- **Pathways** – tools to put the theory into practice (*EBLIP toolkit, PEBL*)

- **Toolkit** – c/o EBLIP Toolkit Development Project
