ECON1001 Microeconomics for Business Decisions

If you have completed both ECON1001 and LEGL1001, these will continue to count toward your program. You will not be required to complete INOV1001 and will be exempt from 10 units of Business major courses.

LEGL1001 Foundations of Law

If you have completed LEGL1001 or ECON1001 but not both, this will continue to count toward your program. You will not be required to complete INOV1001.

If you have NOT completed ECON1001 or LEGL1001, you will be required to complete INOV1001.

Transition Arrangements

Major increased by 10 units and compulsory and course list requirements combined into 1x 80 unit course list.

Removed from major and replaced with core course INOV1001. If you have completed MNGT1002, this will count as a core course.

If you have completed MNGT2007, this will continue to count toward your major. You cannot complete INOV2001.

Replaces course list option MNGT3007. If you have completed MNGT3007 you cannot complete INOV2002.

If you have completed MNGT2002, this will continue to count toward your major. You cannot complete INOV2004.

Replaces course list option MNGT3008. If you have completed MNGT3008 you cannot complete INOV3001.

Replaces course list option MNGT3009. If you have completed MNGT3009 you cannot complete INOV3002.

If you have completed MNGT3016, this will continue to count toward your major. You cannot complete INOV3003.

If you have completed any courses from the pre-2025 major course list, these will continue to count toward your major.

If you have NOT completed 80 units toward your major, you will be required to complete any remaining units* from the 2025 course list. It is recommended that students prioritise INOV2001, INOV2004, INOV3001 and INOV3004.

*Students must complete a minimum 40 of the 80 units at 3000 level.

Transition Arrangements

Major increased by 10 units and compulsory and course list requirements combined into 1x 80 unit course list.

Previously available as course list option. If you have completed MNGT2006, this will continue to count toward your major.

Replaces course list option IRHR3035. If you have completed IRHR3035, this will continue to count toward your major. You cannot complete MNGT3014.

If you have completed any courses from the pre-2025 major course list, these will continue to count toward your major requirements.

If you have NOT completed 80 units toward your major, you will be required to complete any remaining units* from the 2025 course list. It is recommended that students prioritise MNGT2005, MNGT2009, MNGT3011 and MNGT3013.

*Students must complete a minimum 40 of the 80 units at 3000 level.

Frequently Asked Questions

I have completed courses that have been removed from the program, will these still count?

Yes! All completed courses that previously counted toward your program will continue to count however they may count elsewhere in your program, e.g. if you have completed both ECON1001 and LEGL1001 one of these courses will now count toward your major.

Can I take the new courses that have been added to the program?

Yes! If the new courses fit within your program (i.e. you have not completed all your major requirements) and they are not a direct replacement for a course you have already completed, you may choose to take the newly added course options.

My major has increased from 70 units to 80 units, am I required to complete an additional major course?

Yes, unless you have completed both ECON1001 and LEGL1001, you will be required to complete 80 units toward your major.

My plan in program planner still has the old courses in it, what do I need to do?

Program planner will not update your plan/pathway automatically, so if there are discontinued/removed courses still in your plan you may need to remove these manually and add the replacement/new courses in their place. The transition arrangements will be outlined in the “progress” sections of program planner which should assist you in making sure you are planning the right courses. If you need help planning out your remaining courses, please contact Program Advice.

My program planner has been “reviewed”, what does this mean?

In some cases, Program Advice may have reviewed and mapped your remaining program requirements to make it easier for you to follow these transition arrangements. If your plan has been marked as reviewed, you are all set to follow the planned pathway and enrol.
