



SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

SCHOOL OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND LIFE SCIENCES VACATION SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHMENT

This scholarship is available to support a program of supervised research with the School of Environmental and Life Sciences during **Spring and Summer 2025-2026**. The scholarship includes a financial benefit of \$2000, in addition to a non-compulsory research project in *Green and Golden Bell Frog monitoring*.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship the recipient must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in a relevant program with the School of Environmental and Life Sciences, with units completed in Environmental Science and/or Ecology.
- If successful, be willing to complete CARE modules and other induction activities which will be organised by the SELS team.
- Demonstrate an interest in gaining experience in the research topic over the summer vacation period and have previously gained experience with the Conservation Science Research Group.
- Receive this scholarship for one of the advertised survey periods only.

SELECTION

Selection shall be based on nomination by the School of Environmental and Life Sciences. Selection will take into consideration your preferred period of participation (Spring or Summer), academic merit, and any participation in previous years.

BENEFIT

The scholarship provides a benefit of \$2000. This will be paid on acceptance of the scholarship.

The scholarship also provides the non-compulsory opportunity to participate in a research learning experience during one of two survey seasons:

Spring - 2 scholarships will be available for the period October to December 2025

Summer - 2 scholarships will be available for the period January to March 2026

This research will be under academic supervision within the school who will also help determine the details about dates, times and locations.

PERIODS OF LEAVE

This scholarship does not provide a period of leave or deferral.

TERMINATION

A scholarship shall terminate before conclusion when:

- the recipient's circumstances change and eligibility for the scholarship is no longer met,
- the maximum duration of the scholarship has been reached, or
- the recipient provides written notice that they no longer wish to continue on the scholarship.
