To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- **Core courses** – 210 units
- **Major courses** – 70 units from one of the following B Business majors:
 - International Business - 40 units of Compulsory courses and 30 units of Directed courses
 - Leadership and Management – 30 units of Compulsory courses and 40 units of Directed courses
- **Directed courses** – 10 units
- **Elective courses** – 30 units, visit the **Program Handbook** for more information
- The duration of this program is 4 years full-time (40 units per semester), or equivalent part-time
- The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
- Transition information – students who commenced study in this program prior to 2020 may be affected by transition arrangements. Please refer to the **Program Handbook** for further information.
