When is the rink open?	Tuesday 17 September – Friday 20 September between 10.00am -5.00pm.  Additionally there is a Student Event on Wednesday night, a Staff Event Friday night and a Community Day on Saturday 21 September from 10.00am – 4.00pm.
How big is the rink?	10m x 19m including the barrier.
Who can skate?	Anyone visiting our campus is welcome to enjoy the rink.
Are there any age or height restrictions?  How much does it cost?	Children must be 2 years or older, there are no height restrictions. Double runner skates can be provided and helmets and penguins skating aids are available.  It is FREE to skate.
now much does it cost?	It is free to skate.
Do I have to book?	You do not need to book to skate during the day sessions.  Bookings must be made for the Staff Event and the Community Day. Please use the EventBrite links to book those sessions.
Can I book multiple sessions?	Yes, session times for the Staff and Community events are 30 minutes with a 10 minute change over. You can book two sessions to extend to one hour should you wish.
