

PARKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



ATTENTION ALL PERSONS ENTERING THIS PARKING AREA, THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF ENTRY APPLY WHEN YOU ENTER, LEAVE OR BRING YOUR VEHICLE INTO THIS PARKING AREA AND YOU DO SO SUBJECT TO THESE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

1. You enter and use this Parking Area at your own risk and you remain responsible for your vehicle and any property in or on it.
2. We are not liable to you or any person with you for:
 - Injury to you or anybody else;
 - Damage to, destruction of, or theft of your vehicle or any other vehicle;
 - Delivery up of, or the towing of, your vehicle or any other vehicle whether authorised or not; or
 - Damage to, destruction of, theft of or delivery up of any property (including anything in or on your vehicle or any other vehicle),however caused, and you release and indemnify us from any claim which you might otherwise have against us.
3. You agree to indemnify us in respect of any claim made against us as a consequence of, in relation to, or in any way arising out of the use of this Parking Area.
4. You are responsible for any damage to your vehicle if:
 - The vehicle is parked contrary to University parking signs;
 - The vehicle is being used on University property contrary to traffic laws or signage;
 - Damage to your vehicle is the result of impact with another vehicle, however caused; or
 - Damage to your vehicle is the result of an act of God.
5. Infringement notices distributed for illegal parking in this Parking Area are enforceable under The University of Newcastle policy and procedures and NSW law.
6. A parking fee is payable each time a vehicle enters here. If you bring a vehicle into this Parking Area you agree to pay the parking fee as set by us from time-to-time.
7. You agree to:
 - produce and display when requested by us, your parking permit as proof of payment of parking fee;
 - not cause any obstruction;
 - not park anywhere that we designate as a no parking area;
 - not use this Parking Area other than in accordance with instructions that an authorised officer may give;
 - comply with all reasonable directions and requests made by an authorised officer; and
8. If any of these conditions are illegal or unenforceable, the offending part is to be read down or disregarded and does not affect the remaining part.
9. These Parking Terms and Conditions of Entry are subject to any laws which may apply.
10. In these conditions references to:
 - “we”, “us”, “our” and “authorised officer” mean The University of Newcastle, ABN 15 736 576 735, or our employees, agents, contractors or subcontractors;
 - “you” means the person using, or intending to use the Parking Area; and
 - “your vehicle” includes a vehicle driven, or intended to be driven by you into the Parking Area.
