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To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 40 units
- Compulsory Courses – Midwifery Primary Care complete 40 units and Clinical Education complete 20 units of Specialisation-Compulsory courses.
- Directed courses – Research, Leadership and Management and General Specialisation complete 40 units of Directed courses from relevant specialisation list. Clinical Education Specialisation complete 20 units of Directed courses from relevant specialisation list.
- The duration of this program is 1 year full time study, or part time equivalent. The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
- The above enrolment pattern is a recommended pattern only. Students who are working whilst studying would typically complete 10-20 units per term.
- CLAM courses are offered every second year.
