To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses - 160 units.
- ✓ Major courses - 70 units (including all Compulsory courses and the required number of Directed courses for one Major sequence). *** The Marketing Major and the Leadership and Management Major do not require students to complete a 1000 level Major course. Students who have chosen one of these Majors need to complete an extra Elective instead of a 1000 level Major course. The Leadership and Management Major includes some of the Core courses and will require students to complete additional Electives in order to reach 320 units.
- ✓ Electives - 90 units. Visit the [Course Handbook](#) to see a list of available Electives. You may utilise your Electives to undertake a Double Major. Please see the Bachelor of Business/Bachelor of Innovation and Entrepreneurship Double Major Program Plan for details.
- ✓ Students must not exceed 120 units at 1000 level.
- ✓ Students must complete a minimum of 40 units at 2000 and 3000 level.
- ✓ Students who perform well during the program with a credit average (GPA of 5.0) or greater, may apply for a further year of full time (or equivalent part time) study to obtain an Honours degree.
- ✓ The duration of the program is 4 years full time (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
