- Travel must be to one of the following destinations; sites of Greek and/or Roman inhabitation and influence in Greece, Italy, Spain, Southern France, Turkey, and those countries and islands between (e.g. Croatia, Albania, Crete, Cyprus, Malta)
- Successful recipients will be required to provide a written account (500-1000 words) and present an account of their journey to their school or department within one month of their return, identifying ways in which their thinking and understanding about their PhD research has been affected by their experience.

To be eligible to apply, you must be enrolled at the University and meet the following criteria

- Be an Australian citizen or Permanent Resident of Australia
- Be enrolled in a PhD degree in the research areas of Classics or Ancient History;
- Must be enrolled on a full-time or part-time basis at the time of travel;
- Have successfully completed confirmation by the application closing date;
- The principal supervisor deems the applicant's academic progress to be satisfactory;
- Must not have received this scholarship previously;
- Must submit application and required documentation no later than the application closing date;
