To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 10 units
- Students must complete 80 units of study consisting of a combination of one Core course, specialisation Compulsory courses, Directed courses and/or Elective courses. This varies according to the selected specialisation. Visit the [Program Handbook](#) for more information. Electives must be at 6000 level.
- Qualified teachers seeking accreditation in a KLA can complete [EDUC6109 Integrated Fieldwork Studies](#) as a Directed course in their program of study. [EDUC6109](#) should be taken in the final term of study.
- The duration of this program is one year full-time (40 units per semester) or part-time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
