To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed a total of 400 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core courses - 160 units.
- ✓ Major courses - 90-110 units (including all Compulsory courses and the required number of Directed courses for one Major sequence). Where a major requires more than 90 units, these extra courses are completed in place of Approved Science courses.
- ✓ Approved Science courses - 30-50 units depending on choice of Major.
- ✓ Directed courses - 100 units. Refer to the Bachelor of Science [Program Handbook](#) for the list of 1000 level Directed courses and refer to the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) Combined [Program Handbook](#) for the list of 5000 level directed courses.
- ✓ 160 units of Bachelor of Science courses including 60 units at 1000 level and a minimum of 60 units at 3000 level.
- ✓ To find out which 1000 Directed courses you should enrol in see page 3. For further information please see [Enrolling in Maths](#).
- ✓ The duration of this program is 5 years full time (40 units per semester).
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 8 years.
