To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 280 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core Courses - 200 Units.
- ✓ Directed Courses - 80 Units.
- ✓ First year core courses (LAWS6000, LAWS6001, LAWS6120, LAWS6121, LAWS6130, LAWS6140, and LAWS6141) are assumed knowledge for all remaining core courses and should be completed before progressing through the program or commencing Legal Practice.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 3 years full time study, or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 8 years.
