- Core courses – 30 units
- Directed courses – 10 units, visit the [Program Handbook](#) for more information
- BIOS6910: Biostatistics A should be taken before BIOS6920: Biostatistics B (directed course option)
- EPID6420: Fundamentals of Epidemiology should be taken before EPID6430: Advanced Epidemiology (directed course option)
- If chosen as a Directed course, EPID6600: Research Protocol Design should be taken in your final term of study
- Due to course availability, students who commence in Semester 2 are not able to complete the program in a single Semester
- The maximum time to complete this program is 3 years.
- The duration of this program is 6 months full-time (40 units per semester) or part-time equivalent.
- The above full-time enrolment patterns comply with the conditions of international student visas. Failing to follow this enrolment advice may result in international students not being able to graduate within the period of their Confirmation of Enrolment.
