STUDY AT NEW SPACE



MIXED MODE DELIVERY

With our flexible modes of delivery, you can choose to study either by face-to-face, entirely online, or a combination of both.

FEES

As part of the fee structure, you will only be charged for the course/s you're enrolled in. You will be billed on a trimester by trimester basis. The 2019 annual fees for domestic full-fee paying students of the Master of Business Administration is \$23,155, which is based on a full year full time load (80 units). You can either pay your fees to the University directly or, if you are eligible, apply for a FEE-HELP loan from the Australian Government. Fees are subject to change. 
These interactive sessions expose candidates to real-world challenges and showcase how strategic thinking initiatives can deliver organisational solutions to practical problems.
