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To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 400 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core - 190 units (comprised of 160 units of Laws courses & 30 units of Arts courses).
- Major - 80 units.
- Minor - 40 units.
- Electives - 10 units.
- Directed Courses - 80 units. Refer to the [Program Handbook](#) for a list of current courses available and up to date information.
- The duration of this program is 5 years full-time study (40 units per semester).
- The maximum time to complete is 8 years.
- **Some 5000 Level LAWS Directed courses have been replaced with 6000 Level LAWS Directed courses in 2021, all previous 5000 and 6000 Level LAWS Directed courses completed prior to 2021 will count towards this program.**

Note: Education major is only available to students who commenced this program prior to 2021 and have completed 40 units of courses that count towards the Education major. Students who do not meet these criteria can only complete an Education minor.
