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To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 320 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses (including Professional Placement) – 290 units
- Directed Courses – 10 units
- Electives– 20 units.
- Students must complete a minimum of 40 units at all levels (1000, 2000, 2000 and 4000), and can complete a maximum of 120 units at 1000 level. Visit the [Program Handbook](#) for more information
