BACHELOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE AND MANAGEMENT / BACHELOR OF BUSINESS

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 240 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses - 160 units.
- Mathematic Directed course - 10 units
- One major from the Bachelor of Environmental Science and Management - 80 or 90 units (depending on the major chosen).
- One major from the Bachelor of Business – 60 or 70 units (depending on the major chosen). The Marketing Major and the Leadership and Management Major do not require students to complete a 1000 level Major course.
- Due to unit restrictions, only the following major combinations are possible:
 - Earth Systems: Can only be taken with Leadership and Management, or Marketing Bachelor of Business Majors.
 - Ecosystems and Biodiversity: Can be taken with any Bachelor of Business Major.
 - Marine Science: Can only be taken with Leadership and Management, or Marketing Bachelor of Business Majors.
 - Sustainability: Can be taken with any Bachelor of Business Major.
- *Electives – up to 10 units of electives, depending upon choice of BESM and BBus majors undertaken. Visit the [Course Handbook](#) to see a list of available Electives. If you choose an 80 unit BESM major and a 60 unit BBus major you will have room for 10 units of electives.
- The duration of this program is 4 years full time (40 units per semester) or part time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 10 years.
