RUBRIC

Objectives:

- To assess applicants' understanding of the Ma & Morley Scholarship Program values.
- To identify applicants' level of alignment to the Ma & Morley Scholarship Program values in their current personal lives.
- To gain an understanding of how an applicant will use their degree or future endeavours to make a difference in one or more of the Ma & Morley Scholarship Program values.

First Question:

- Discuss your understanding of one or more of the Ma & Morley Scholarship Program values and why they are important for creating positive change in the world. In your response include relevant examples of:
 - o Current events, influential individuals and/or social movements that align with these values and that inspire you
 - o How your current actions and life choices align with these values

Second Question:

• Explain how you plan to use your degree and experience to make a positive impact in one or more of the Ma & Morley Scholarship Program values in the future. In your response, discuss the change you expect to see in the future as a result of your commitment to the Program's values.

Notes:

Both questions should be integrated into an 800-word response – we suggest that applicants spend 400 words per question, as both questions are weighted equally.
