

Health and Safety Management System: Element 10



Monitoring, Measurement and Review

1. Intent

The University will monitor and review health and safety performance to identify trends and measure progress, to provide assurance that the University's Health and Safety Management System Framework is effective.

2. Commitment

University Council and Executive Committee

The University Council and Executive Committee commit to:

- Oversee an annual review of the Health and Safety Management System Framework to ensure it remains relevant and consistent with Regulatory requirements and continues to address the operational needs of the University.

Leaders and Supervisors

Leaders and Supervisors commit to:

- Support health surveillance programs for Workers that may have potential exposure to hazards;
- Implement and maintain controls that are required to minimise the risk of occupational exposures;
- Cooperate with and contribute to internal and external health and safety audits and monitor implementation of actions arising; and
- Contribute to an annual review of the Health and Safety Management System Framework by providing feedback to the Health and Safety Team on where amendments and improvements may be required.

Workers

Workers commit to:

- Comply with health surveillance programs; and
- Provide information as and when required in order to provide input to health and safety monitoring and measurement processes.
