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To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 40 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 40 units
- The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
- The duration of this program is 1 year of part time study. Due to course availability, it cannot be completed full time.
- The above enrolment pattern is recommended only. Students who are working whilst studying would typically complete 10 – 20 units per term.
- Students continuing to the Graduate Diploma in Workplace Health and Safety will receive full credits for the Graduate Certificate in Workplace Health and Safety courses completed
