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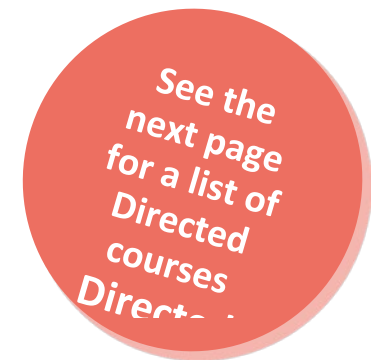
Program Plan Key: = Compulsory = Directed

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core Courses - 40 Units.
- ✓ Directed Courses - 40 Units.
- ✓ EDUC6116 replaces EDUC6016, EDUC6117 replaces EDUC6017, EDUC6119 replaces EDUC6019 and EDUC6120 replaces EDUC6020. Students who have successfully completed the previous version of a core course must not enroll in the equivalent version of that course.
- ✓ Enrolment in Minor Thesis courses is by application, students must submit a manual enrolment [form](#) to the School of Education to seek permission. EDUC6026 Minor Thesis A is completed before EDUC6027 Minor Thesis B in consecutive terms of study.
- ✓ Enrolment in EDUC6048 Research Methodology plus either EDUC6049 Research Methodology Qualitative or EDUC6050 Research Methodology Quantitative is recommended to support successful completion of Minor Thesis A and B.
- ✓ With the permission of the Program Convenor, postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Education and Arts from outside the ML&ME program may be approved as electives in this program in place of Directed courses.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 1 year full time study, or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
- ✓ Course availability is subject to change.
