- Enrolment in Minor Thesis courses is by application, students must submit a manual enrolment form to the School of Education to seek permission. EDUC6026 Minor Thesis A is completed before EDUC6027 Minor Thesis B in consecutive terms of study.
- Enrolment in EDUC6048 Research Methodology plus either EDUC6049 Research Methodology 2: Qualitative or EDUC6050 Research Methodology 1: Quantitative is recommended to support completion of Minor Thesis A and B.
- With permission from the Program Convenor postgraduate courses offered by the School of Education outside the ML&ME program may be approved as electives in place of Directed courses in this program.
- The duration of this program is one year full-time (40 units per semester) or part-time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
