

How to request an article using ArticleReach Direct

If you have checked the [Library catalogue](#) and found that the article you need is not held by the Library you can then submit an ArticleReach request.

You can search the [ArticleReach](#) catalogue directly and submit a request or use the ArticleReach Direct links displayed in the Library's catalogue.

For demonstration purpose we are looking for the article, *Advances in fine and coarse particle flotation*, in the journal *Canadian Metallurgical quarterly*, Vol.49, 2010, pp. 328-330.

From your journal title search results you can select the ArticleReach link in the top right corner.



Select the journal title you require from the list, to find a library which has physical copies of the journal you require. **This is important, as you are unable to request articles from online versions of journals from ArticleReach libraries.**

Check each entry to display the ArticleReach partner libraries which hold copies of the journal you require.

In this example the first entry fall outside the publication years required. Select the second entry.

Receiving and Viewing Your Requests

You will be notified by **email** when your article arrives. Requests are usually supplied in 2-4 days.

You will be able to view your article in either two ways:

- A link to your copy will be sent to you by email,

OR

- You can log into My Library and after selecting Article Requests you can click on the link that will take you to the article.

IMPORTANT: The document link will be available to be used for 30 days so you are advised to save a copy if it will be needed for future reference.
