HOW TO ENROL IN THE DUAL PROGRAM WITH LUISS AND WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

- For students who commenced midyear, after the successful completion of your first year of study of the MBA (Global) (minimum of eight courses) at the University of Newcastle (which is delivered in English), there is no requirement for additional English testing.
- LUISS Business School requires that students complete an aptitude test online.
- The University of Newcastle will provide LUISS with the academic transcript for any applicants, with a recommendation regarding enrolment.
- Applicants will be asked to undertake an interview with LUISS staff by Skype, to help the staff and applicants with the decision process.
- If accepted, students will start their program at LUISS in August/ September.
- Applications will be due in March and conditional offers will be made in May. Confirmation of offers will depend on final marks.

FEES

The fee for each of the LUISS programs is EURO €14,000, which is payable to LUISS.
