As the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic), Professor Evans is responsible for providing strategic and innovative leadership to ensure the University delivers on its NeW Futures goals. He leads the transformation of the University’s education and academic endeavours, and continues to deliver equity of access and success, a great student experience and strong graduate outcomes. Professor Evans is an active teacher focusing on structural and functional anatomy and embryology in all health related disciplines as well as biological and biomedical sciences. He has been awarded an array of national and international education awards and honours and is internationally recognised for advances and creativity in higher education practice. Professor Evans is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Biology, the Royal Microscopical Society, the UK Higher Education Academy and the Anatomical Society (FAS). He is also an Honorary Fellow and Founder of the Monash Education Academy and holds an Honorary Professorship for the Warwick-Monash Alliance.
