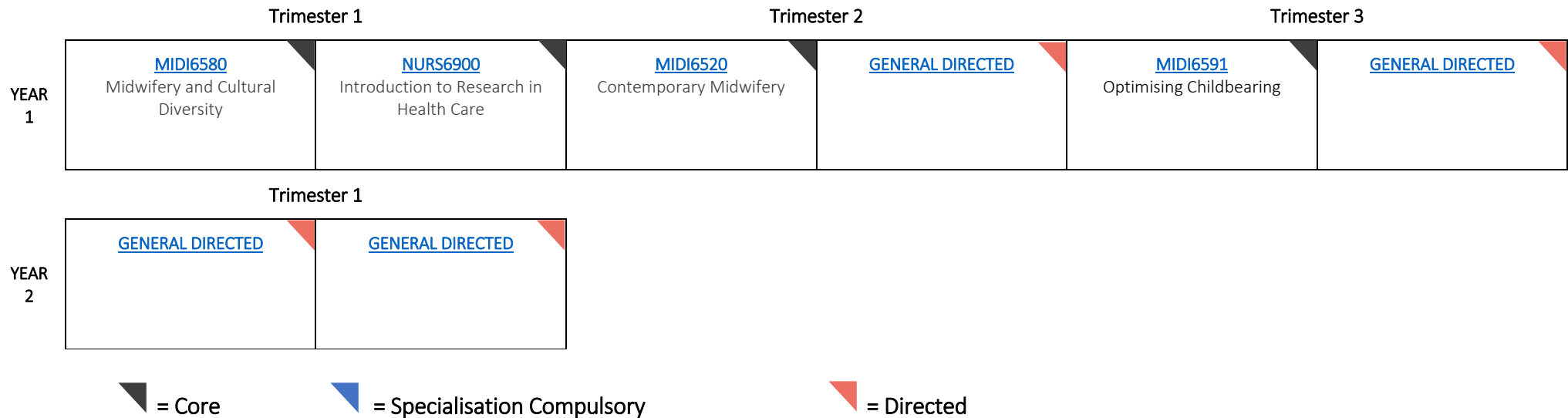

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Core Courses - 40 Units.
- ✓ Compulsory Courses – Midwifery Primary Care and Clinical Education complete 40 units of Specialisation-Compulsory courses.
- ✓ Directed courses – Research, Leadership and Management, Family Health and General Specialisation complete 40 units of Directed courses from relevant specialisation list.
- ✓ The duration of this program is 1 years full time study, or part time equivalent.
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
- ✓ The above enrolment pattern is a recommended pattern only. Students who are working whilst studying would typically complete 10-20 units per term.
- ✓ CLAM courses are only offered every second year.
