



Assessment & Adjustments

This guide is designed to support staff to implement reasonable adjustments in the classroom, therefore allowing students to reach their full academic potential and create an environment that promotes independence and success.

Note: Please refer to the individual *Reasonable Adjustment Plan* for each student to determine which adjustment(s) listed here is applicable to their situation.

ADJUSTMENT	DESCRIPTION OF ADJUSTMENT	REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT IN CLASS/COURSE
Extensions for assignments and take-home exams	A student may have a health condition or disability that may require extensions of time on some of their assessments.	<p>Allow a student to use their <i>Reasonable Adjustment Plan</i> to request an extension for an assignment and/or take-home exam.</p> <p>Advise the student to follow the Adverse Circumstances process when seeking an extension. They may use the <i>Reasonable Adjustment Plan</i> as a supporting document for this request.</p> <p>If you have concerns about this adjustment, please contact AccessAbility.</p>
Adjustment or alternative for group assessment	A student may have a health condition that causes significant difficulties participating in group work.	If the student requests an alternative assessment, please discuss options with the student.



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Adjustments or alternative for oral presentation	A student may have a health condition that causes significant difficulties completing oral presentations.	If the student requests an alternative assessment, please discuss options with the student.
Adjustment or alternative for field trip	A student may be unable to access field trips due to mobility or physical limitations and adjustments may be required.	If the student requests an alternative assessment, please discuss options with the student.
