# MASTER OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND LAW

To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 40 units
- Directed Courses – 40 units (10 units from Group A, 10 units from Group B, and the remaining 20 units from Group A or Group B).
- Students must successfully complete GSBS6006 before enrolling in GSBS6507.
- Students must have successfully completed, or be concurrently enrolled in, LEGL6004 to enrol in LAWS6024.
- The duration of this program is 1 year full-time (80 units across one academic year) or part-time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years.
