



SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

FEBE INTERNATIONAL ARCHITECTURE AND BUILT ENVIRONMENT POSTGRADUATE COURSEWORK SCHOLARSHIP

ESTABLISHMENT

This scholarship has been established to encourage and support academically gifted international students to study a postgraduate coursework degree program with the Faculty, with the long-term view to continuation into a Higher Degree Research candidature.

FUNDING ARRANGEMENT

This is a faculty funded scholarship from the Faculty of Engineering and Built Environment.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for an offer of this scholarship, you will need to:

- Be commencing an eligible FEBE Architecture and Built Environment postgraduate coursework program at the University of Newcastle.
- Be enrolled full time and studying on-campus at Callaghan.
- Meet the tiered GPA level requirements.
- Be a full-fee paying international student.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

As part of your application, you will need to prepare:

- No supporting documents are required for this scholarship.

SELECTION

No application is required. Scholarships will be awarded automatically to students upon application to study an eligible FEBE Architecture and Built Environment postgraduate coursework degree program at the University of Newcastle.

Scholarship offers will be made on the basis of academic merit:

- Tier 1: UON determined GPA 6.0 at entry
- Tier 2: UON determined GPA 5.5 at entry
- Tier 3: UON determined GPA 5.0 at entry

Scholarship offers will be approved by one or more of the following members:

- Pro Vice Chancellor, Faculty of Engineering and Built Environment or nominee, and/or
- Assistant Dean (International), Faculty of Engineering and Built Environment, if required.

The applicant must **not** be in receipt of any other FEBE Fee Waiver Scholarships.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

If accepting this scholarship, you agree to the following conditions:

- You will continue to meet relevant eligibility criteria (see the section titled “Eligibility” above) for the duration of the scholarship, unless special consideration is approved (see below).
- You will maintain full-time enrolment and satisfactory academic progress for the duration of the scholarship.
- The scholarship is tenable for up to two (2) years of the postgraduate program. This tenure may be reduced if the scholar has completed units of study in the eligible program prior to the scholarship offer.
- If your circumstances change in a way that impacts your eligibility (e.g., change in study load or withdrawal from study), you agree to notify scholarships@newcastle.edu.au.

BENEFIT

This scholarship is ongoing for the remaining length of the program up to a maximum term of 2 years provided ongoing eligibility. This scholarship must be taken up in the year for which it is awarded.

The scholarship benefit received will vary depending on your GPA at entry:

- **Tier 1: GPA 6.0 at entry - Term based programs \$750 per 10 units**
- **Tier 2: GPA 5.5 at entry - Term based programs \$500 per 10 units**
- **Tier 3: GPA 5.0 at entry - Term based programs \$250 per 10 units**

The scholarship provides a tuition fee waiver which ranges from \$4,000 to \$12,000 over the full 2-year tenure provided ongoing eligibility for the term of the scholarship.

The scholarship will be paid as a tuition fee waiver, reducing tuition fee liability. The tuition fee waiver will be applied after census date each semester/trimester.

The scholarship benefit and number of scholarships awarded may vary and will be determined by the funding available each year.

PERIODS OF LEAVE

You may apply in writing to scholarships@newcastle.edu.au for consideration to reserve your scholarship if you are unable to study or travel due to illness, injury, or other extenuating circumstances. An application must be supported by documentary evidence.

Periods of approved leave for the scholarship:

- must not exceed two consecutive semesters of study; and
- will not be counted towards the term of the scholarship.

TERMINATION

Unless terminated earlier, the scholarship will end when the term has expired, and the total benefit has been paid.

Student Central Scholarships staff may terminate the scholarship before the term has expired if:

- The scholarship conditions are not met, including relevant eligibility criteria being maintained;
- The scholar completes study and/or ceases to be a student with University of Newcastle; or
- The scholar has committed serious misconduct (as determined in accordance with the University’s relevant policies and rules).

If the scholarship is terminated early, the faculty funding the scholarship will be notified.

Ongoing scholarships will not be paid out in full in instances where the recipient completes study before the full scholarship term has expired.

If you have provided false or misleading information and as a result you were awarded or continued to receive the scholarship, the scholarship may be stopped, and you may be required to repay any scholarship benefits to which you are not entitled to within 14 days of being requested to do so by the University.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION

As a scholarship recipient, if you are unable to meet the conditions of the scholarship due to illness, injury or other extenuating circumstances, you may apply for special consideration. Please apply by writing to the Scholarships Officer via email to scholarships@newcastle.edu.au. Please provide appropriate documentary evidence to support your request.

A decision will be made by Student Central Scholarships staff in consultation with the Faculty of Engineering and Built Environment.
