To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 280 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- Core courses – 210 units
- Directed Courses – 70 units, visit the [Program Handbook](#) to access the list of [Directed courses](#) offered.
- First year Core courses (LAWS6000, LAWS6001, LAWS6120, LAWS6121, LAWS6130, LAWS6140, and LAWS6141) are assumed knowledge for all remaining core courses and should be completed before progressing through the program and commencing Legal Practice when studying part-time.
- Legal Practice 1 courses LAWS6014A and LAWS6014B and Legal Practice 2 courses LAWS6015A, LAWS6015B and LAWS6118 are taken over two consecutive years.
- Students enrol in LAWS6118 Final Year Workplace Experience in Semester 1 if the placement hours are completed over Summer plus Semester 1, or enrol in LAWS6118 in Semester 2 if the placement hours are completed over Semesters 1 and 2.
- The duration of this program is 3 years full-time, or part-time equivalent.
- The maximum time to complete this program is 8 years.
