2. Applicants who have completed a recognised MBA within the preceding ten years may gain 80 units of credit into the program.
3. Applicants who have completed a recognised Master of Business or other relevant Masters qualification in the preceding ten years may gain some credit, determined by the Pro Vice-Chancellor of the Faculty of Business and Law. The course outlines for the courses need to be provided with the application for assessment.

In order to qualify for the award, a student must pass a total of 240 units comprising core courses – apart from 40 units of prescribed courses in Year 2.
