## **APA BASICS**

#### **GENERAL**

- APA is an in-text referencing style. This means that short referencing information (Author, Date) must be included in the text of your assignment when you quote information from outside sources. Full details of references used are then included in a reference list at the end of the document.
- References cited in-text must appear in the reference list and vice versa. The only exceptions are personal communications and classical works see libguides.newcastle.edu.au/apa-7th/reference-list for more information.

#### **IN-TEXT CITATIONS**

- When inserting a citation into the text of your document, include the authors' surnames and the year of publication, enclosed in parentheses, e.g. (Smith & Jones, 2016). This brief citation allows the reader to find the appropriate full reference in the list at the end of the document.
- If you include a direct quote (word-for-word), the in-text citation must include the page number/s where the quotation appeared, e.g. ... "correct referencing is a necessity" (Smith & Jones, 2016, p. 16).
- For multiple in-text citations within parentheses, alphabetise citations by first author and add a semi-colon (;) between them to differentiate citations, e.g. (Smith & Jones, 2016; Williams, 2014).
- Use "and" when citing authors' names in sentences and "&" for parentheses. E.g. Smith and Jones (2016) ... versus ... (Smith & Jones, 2016).

#### **REFERENCE LIST**

- The reference list starts on a separate page and is always organised in alphabetical order. Do not use numbers or bullet points.
- The second and subsequent lines of each reference in the list must have a hanging indent.

#### THINGS TO LOOK OUT FOR

• When you have multiple resources from <u>exactly the same</u> authors in the same year, <u>alphabetise by title</u> for your reference list and then add a, b, c, and so on after the year to differentiate the references for the in-text citations. For example:

Smith, D. (2014a). Care facilities for the elderly [Brochure]. NSW Health.

Smith, D. (2014b). Hand hygiene [Pamphlet]. NSW Health.

The in-text references would then be (Smith, 2014a) or (Smith, 2014b), depending on which document you cite.

- Capitalise all names and proper nouns as appropriate. Examples include Generation Z, YouTube, iPad, and PowerPoint.
- Digital Object Identifiers (DOIs) are important for APA 7 and need to be included as part of reference list entries (where provided). Examples in this guide show which resources are likely to include DOIs. For more information see <a href="libguides.newcastle.edu.au/apa-7th/DOIs">libguides.newcastle.edu.au/apa-7th/DOIs</a>
- APA 7 no longer requires access URLS for ebooks from library/database sources. Only include URLs for ebooks found via the web.

## NOTE: APA 7 has changed the expectations for referencing books and ebooks:

- DOIs (where provided) and publisher names are now standard for both print and ebook formats.
- Where a book/ebook is accessed from the Library or a database (and does not have a DOI), do not include the place of publication or access link.
- Where an ebook is accessed from the general web (no log-in is required), include the full access link.

## **COMMON ABBREVIATIONS USED IN APA 7**

Ed. or Eds.	Used for editor or editors. Do not confuse with edition (below).
ed.	Used for editions. You do not need to include edition information for a 'standard' first edition.
et al.	This is used for in-text citations when there are three or more authors to mean 'and others'.
n.d.	Used for references that have no publication/creation date listed.
p. or pp.	p. is used for single page citations; pp. when multiple pages are involved [Examples, p. 302 or pp. 12-13]
para. or paras.	para. is used for a web page paragraph; use paras. for multiple paragraphs [Count the paragraphs on the page, e.g. para. 3]
