INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHO COMMENCED IN THE BACHELOR OF DESIGN (ARCHITECTURE) [10028] PRIOR TO 2023

The University is incorporating Work Integrated Learning (WIL) into all undergraduate programs as a 10-unit Core Course (ARBE3030 – Work Integrated Learning in the Built Environment), for students commencing in the program from 2023 onwards. WIL provides students from all disciplines and backgrounds with the opportunity to gain real world work experience and improve employability outcomes.

Transition Arrangements

ARBE1105 has been removed from the pre-2023 program. Students who commenced the degree prior to 2023, who have not successfully completed ARBE1105, will need to complete a choice of either ARBE3030 or ARBE3225. Students who have successfully completed ARBE1105, may choose to complete ARBE3030 as an Elective, should they have space within their program.
