However, if they do not have room, and they have completed the correct number of units of CAPA/CIND courses (60 units for FTA, 40 units for ATA) then they will be deemed to have met the requirements for Drama as a teaching area</p>
Earth & Environmental Science	<p>BIOL1001 and BIOL1002 have been added to Course List A. A new First Teaching Area has been established. Additional course options have been added to both the FTA and ATA lists.</p> <p>Students who have completed EDUC4110 and an elective following Education Compulsory Option 2, will be granted two electives.</p> <p>Students who have not completed EDUC4110 and/or an elective following Education Compulsory Option 2 may select other courses in their place from the Course List.</p>
<p>Geography</p>	<p>The Directed Course list in the First Teaching Area has been split into three Course Lists. Course List A, B and C to differentiate Human Geography and Physical Geography studies. The Directed Course list in the Additional Teaching Area has been split into two Course Lists. <p>Industrial Technology Engineering</p>	<p>ARBE1201 and EDUC2245 have been removed from the Compulsory List ENGG1500 has been added to the Compulsory List The Education Compulsory Option 1 and Option 2 has been replaced with a simplified Course List. EDUC4110 and a 10 unit elective have been removed.</p> <p>Students who have completed EDUC4110 or EDUC2245 will be deemed to have completed ENGG1500 and/or ENGG2500. The Program Convenor will assist impacted students with individualised plans. Investigating Science	<p>GEOS3280 has been removed from the program. Students who have completed GEOS2180 will have the course count towards Earth and Environmental Science Course List for Investigating Science, or the Earth and Environmental Science FTA.</p> <p>PHYS2100 and PHYS2300 have been removed from the Earth and Environmental Sciences Directed Courses List and will now count towards the Physics Course List. Students who have completed too many PHYS courses will have PHYS2100 and PHYS2300 count towards Physics course list for Investigating Science, or Physics FTA.</p> <p>ENVS2004, ENVS2005, ENVS2006, ENVS3002, ENVS3003 and ENVS3004 have been removed from the Biology Course List and will now count towards the Earth and Environmental Sciences Course List. 	<p>CHEM1110 has been removed from the Chemistry Course List. Students who have completed this course before Semester 2 2023 will have these courses count towards the Physics course list for Investigating Science, or Physics FTA.</p> <p>Students who have not yet completed either PHYS1200 or PHYS1250 are free to complete ANY Physics course from the new directed list.</p>

Students who have completed MATH2920 prior to Semester 2 2023 will not be required to complete MATH2920.</p> <p>MATH2340 has been removed from the Compulsory Course List. Students who have completed this course before Semester 2 2023 will have this course count towards the 2000 level requirement for Mathematics, or Extended Studies in Mathematics, or an elective.</p> <p>STAT1070 has been removed from the Compulsory Course List and will Count Towards the Extended Studies in Mathematics Course List, or as an elective course.</p> <p><u>Extended Studies in Mathematics</u> Students undertaking Mathematics as a First Teaching Area can choose to study Extended Studies in Mathematics through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completing 40 units of Electives from the Extended Studies in Mathematics Course List or • Completing 60 units from the Extended Studies in Mathematics Course List (to complete Extended Studies as an Additional Teaching Area). <p>STAT2020, STAT2300, STAT3030, STAT3040, STAT3800 have been removed from the Extended Studies in Mathematics Directed List B.
