
NEWCASTLE KNIGHTS UNIVERSITY PATHWAY PROGRAM



This program is designed to support Knights players and staff to fulfil their full academic potential while balancing sporting and work commitments. To help you navigate this program, you will have dedicated support throughout.

Upon completion, the pathway provides you with entry into all degrees at the University of Newcastle and access to our Guaranteed Admissions Scheme, which includes over 70 programs!



As a player or staff member of the Knights, you will receive credit for Recognised Prior Learning (RPL) to accelerate your pathway.



Study Options

OPTION 1: LEARN TOGETHER

Study together with your teammates or colleagues and complete two foundational courses:

- Fundamental Mathematics (EPMATH109) Build confidence and skills in numeracy, arithmetic, fractions, decimals, percentages, ratio and scale measurement, basic statistics and units of measurement.
- Research in Action (EPHUMA135) Allows students to explore
 a topic of personal interest through an independent research
 project, developing skills in research methods, academic
 communication, ethical enquiry, and critical thinking.

OPTION 2: CHOOSE YOUR OWN PATH - FLEXIBLE ONLINE STUDY

Where will you study?

ONLINE SELF-DIRECTED STUDY

Each week, access your learning materials through Canvas, including recorded lectures, weekly modules, and assignment uploads. Engage online using tools like email, discussion boards, polls, and so on.

KNIGHTS CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE

Attend sessions at the Knights Centre of Excellence, delivered by dedicated University of Newcastle academics. This option offers a supportive, team-based environment where you can learn alongside fellow players and staff.

ON CAMPUS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEWCASTLE

You'll also have the opportunity to attend classes at the University's Callaghan campus. This gives you access to facilities, face-to-face learning experiences, and the chance to immerse yourself in university life.

When can I start?

The 2025 program starts on Monday, 21 July, and ends on Friday, 14 November. Upon successful completion, you will graduate with an Open Foundation certificate. This will give you guaranteed access to over 70 degree programs at the University of Newcastle.

There is no cost to participate. The Knights University Pathway Program is your FREE pathway to university.
