To be eligible to graduate make sure you have completed 80 units (10 units = 1 course unless otherwise specified) which meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Medical Specialisation
 - Core & Compulsory courses – 80 units
 - Completion of the degree requires attendance at four (4) two-day workshops in Sydney
- ✓ Health Specialisation
 - Core courses – 50 units
 - Directed courses – 30 units (*Please note: Directed courses can be undertaken in Semesters and Trimesters. For term dates, please see [Key Dates](#)*)
 - Completion of the degree requires attendance at two (2) two-day workshops in Sydney
- ✓ The duration of this program is 2 years part time
- ✓ The maximum time to complete this program is 4 years
- ✓ The above enrolment pattern is a recommended pattern only. Students who are working whilst studying would typically complete 10-20 units per term
